### *SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION*

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Application Deadline is **May 15, of each year. No applications will be accepted after this date.**

#### **The following items are to be included with the application:**

- A small photograph.
- A brief, one page, autobiography that outlines your goals and objectives, significance of special activities and/or awards, your vocational objective, and the importance of future training in the achievement of these goals.
- **Official, sealed** transcript of grades from high school or college.
- **Two (2), original** letters of recommendation to include: One should be from someone who can comment on your academic skills, i.e. counselor, teacher, or college instructor, and one from an adult that is acquainted with you outside of school (this person cannot be a relative).
- **Essay**, each applicant must submit an essay of at least **250** words but no more than **500** words. The essay must be typewritten. Applicants should write on the following topic: **“What is the biggest problem facing youth and what would you do to correct it”**.

#### **Selection:**

- The awards committee will carefully review the entire application of each candidate.
- Major emphasis will be placed on academic ability, need and potential to succeed in postsecondary education. Some consideration will be given to personal attributes and extracurricular activities.
- Students are eligible for scholarship consideration to attend any accredited vocational college or university in America. There is no limitation.
- Minimum amount of the award is \$1000.00.
